DON'T POACH THE POWDER

Winter closures exist to protect critical habitat for a variety of wildlife species, including big horn sheep, elk, moose, and mule deer.

When we disturb wildlife, we force them to expend precious energy, which can lead to stress, malnutrition and ultimately death

Wildlife rely on wind-swept hillsides to survive including outside of winter closure areas



Poaching closure areas is a crime carrying a penalty of up to \$5,000 or 6 months in jail
